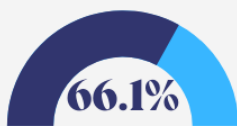

AIR POLLUTION IS THE WORLD'S TOP KILLER

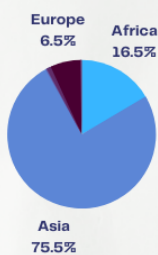
201,006,008 people died due to air pollution from 1990–2019.



OUTDOOR VS INDOOR AIR POLLUTION



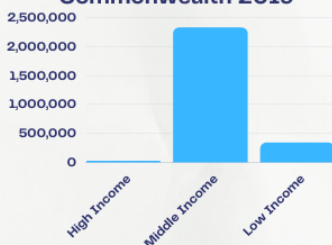
In 2019, a total of 6,820,184 deaths had been recorded. Statistically, **66.1 %** of deaths are caused by outdoor air pollution in contrast to **33.9 %** that are caused by indoor air pollution.



Distribution of Deaths due to Air Pollution by Continents in 2019

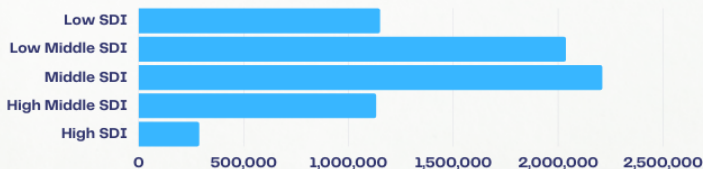
The **majority** of deaths happened in **Asia**. Oceania, North America & Southern Latin America only account for **1.5 %** of total deaths in the world.

Deaths from Air Pollution in Commonwealth 2019

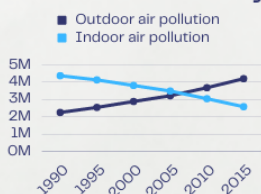


The number of deaths from air pollution in the **middle-income countries** is the **most**, followed by the low-income countries and the high-income countries.
